Organization

--The thesis is a clear, complex sentence in the introduction.

--Topic sentences are strong, and they support the thesis.

--The conclusion restates the thesis in new terms.

Body Paragraphs

--There is a clear topic sentence.

--There are two to three sets of evidence supporting the topic sentence (CERs or better).

--There are transitions that show the relationship between ideas.

--There is a conclusion that relates back to the thesis statement.

Sentences

--There are a variety of sentences (simple, complex, compound).

--Precise words are used throughout the paper.

--There is correct punctuation and grammar throughout the paper.

--Sources are cited correctly.
